Hey everyone!

I want to thank you for supporting us in our recent request on the school ballot for increased funding. Of all the libraries that made requests, our district had the highest percentage of support. I'm so encouraged by this, and excited about the ways we'll be able to serve the community better because of increased secure funding.

The end of May and June are quiet as far as public programming go, but we're busy in other ways. We have a full round of class visits, including preschool classrooms and field trips from LACS and other area schools. We're also preparing for the Summer Reading Program.

We just completed the annual Hooked on Books program with Head Start, which we do in collaboration with the Lowville Elks Lodge. We had the opportunity to go into 4 classrooms, with a total of 70 children, talk about the library and reading, read a story, and give each child a bag of books. It was great to see their excitement!

Summer Reading will kick off at the Storywalk on June 27th, with weekly classes and special events to follow. Registration is open now, and you can find event details at the library or on Facebook. We're excited!
